

2024 Saskatchewan Trucking Association Scholarship Application

The Saskatchewan Trucking Association (STA) Scholarship Program is designed to support those individuals attending post-secondary institutions. Please pay special attention to the basic criteria as there are changes from previous years.

Our basic criteria are as follows:

- Must be a dependent of an employee or an employee of an STA member company.
- Application must be received no later than June 30.
- High school graduate.
- Application is complete.
- Transcripts are received.
- Confirmation of application to a post-secondary institution with a student ID number.
- Applicant's studies <u>must</u> be focused on a field that is applicable to the transportation industry, please contact the STA office if you are unsure.
- Preference will be given to applicants who will be attending school in the Province of Saskatchewan.
- Applicants are only eligible to win the scholarship grant once.

Applicants that have been chosen to receive one of three \$1,000 scholarships will be notified in writing. By applying, the applicant agrees to be acknowledged at the STA's Annual Awards Banquet & Gala, in newsletters, and on various website publications. All Awards will be mailed directly to the applicant's confirmed school to be applied against their tuition for the year.
